Será apresentada e discutida pesquisa em andamento sobre a escrita do estudante em contexto universitário britânico. O interesse está em possibilitar a verificação, para o caso dessa pesquisa, de teorias e pesquisas anteriormente desenvolvidas pelo professor Street e outros especialistas do chamado *NewLiteracy Studies*, bem como as implicações mais gerais sobre as relações entre discurso, identidade e poder no contexto acadêmico. Apesar do avanço dos estudos sobre escrita acadêmica nos EUA, trabalhos recentes produzidos na Grã-Bretanha e filiados à perspectiva dos estudos do letramento têm relacionado questões teóricas sobre discurso e poder a fenômenos usualmente tratados por autores americanos como puramente técnicos. Será focalizado, sobretudo, o *Widening Participation Programme*, do *King's College*, mas também poderão ser verificadas essas relações no caso da escrita dos participantes do seminário.

Com base em diferentes exemplos de pesquisa etnográfica, serão explorados conceitos e traços metodológicos básicos da metodologia etnográfica, com particular ênfase na pesquisa educacional. O objetivo dos seminários é o de familiarizar os participantes com questões conceituais e teóricas de interesse para o desenho e a implementação da pesquisa etnográfica. Para isso, serão utilizados diferentes procedimentos e dinâmicas de trabalho com o grupo de participantes: desde a apresentação e discussão de temas e contribuições bibliográficas relevantes, até a discussão de questões de pesquisa de interesse dos participantes em seus contextos específicos de pesquisa. Para as discussões em pequenos grupos das questões

específicas escolhidas para estudo, deverão ser elaborados previamente descrições sucintas das questões de pesquisa e dos traços contextuais considerados relevantes.

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SÚMULA CURRICULAR DO PROF. BRIAN STREET

O Prof. Street é considerado um expoente dos estudos do letramento, particularmente dos estudos filiados ao chamado New Literacy Studies (NLS)., que compreende o letramento enquanto prática social. Atualmente, é professor de Language in Education, na School of Education do King's College, London University, Inglaterra.

Desenvolveu pesquisa antropológica no Irã na década de 1970 e desde então tem trabalhado sobretudo nos EUA, na Grã-Bretanha e na África do Sul, além de participações em programas de ensino e pesquisa em diferentes países. Tem se voltado extensivamente para o estudo das práticas de letramento em contextos diversos, tanto em estudos teóricos quanto aplicados, com inúmeras contribuições em livros e artigos, além de comunicações e conferências em diferentes eventos e instituições.

Além de sua obra mais conhecida, *Literacy in Theory and Practice* (1985), fundamental para os estudos do letramento, inclusive no Brasil, tem editado volumes também importantes para esse campo, como é o caso do também conhecido volume *Cross-Cultural Approaches to Literacy*, (1993), além de outras contribuições mais recentes, listadas a seguir.
